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Dear parent/guardian,

I am writing to remind you of our Wood Dale School District 7 Winter Choral Concert on **Wednesday, December 18th at 7pm** at the Center of the Arts at the Wood Dale Jr. High School. Your son/daughter has been working very hard preparing for this concert! Both the 4th Grade chorus and the 5th Grade chorus will sing independently and will also combine with all choir students, 4th through 8th Grade, to sing together for the grand finale.

Your child's participation in this concert is extremely important, as it is the culmination of everything we have been learning in choir this year. This date has been on our district calendar since last year, and we can't wait to show you what we have been learning. Additionally, it's a great opportunity to preview the choral program at the junior high and see where your child will be singing in just a year or two. Thank you in advance for marking this date on your calendar.

Concert dress will be white on top and black on bottom. **Boys** will need to wear a **white dress shirt, black pants, black socks, and black dress shoes**. **Girls** will need to wear a **white shirt or blouse, black pants or black skirt (the length must go past knees), black socks or black nylons, and black dress shoes**. Black gym shoes are **NOT** allowed! The concert begins at 7 pm and all students should meet in the junior high music room no later than 6:30 pm to warm-up. Students should enter through door number 4.
